## Epiphany: Let Your Light Shine

*"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven."*  
Matthew 5: 14-16

On the Feast Day of Epiphany we celebrate the revelation of Jesus' birth to the magi who come from the East to find the Christ child. Epiphany is a Greek word that means, "appearance." The Feast Day of Epiphany, January 6th, marks the end of the Christmas season.

The past few years Trinity Church has celebrated The Feast Day of Epiphany with the burning of an Epiphany bonfire. The Christmas trees that decorated our homes are now used to fuel the fire which brings the Epiphany light. In early Christian tradition this fire represented the light that illumined the path of the magi as they made their way to the Christ child.

For us, Epiphany is an annual reminder that the revelation of Jesus as the Savior of

the world is a message that is to be shared with the world.

Our bishop, The Rt. Rev. Andy Doyle, is asking that all Episcopal churches in the Diocese

of Texas, on April 26th, share that message of Good News with one another. He is inviting groups composed of eight to twelve individuals to gather in homes across the diocese for a time of breaking bread together and sharing our common faith.

Each gathering will have a trained facilitator to help guide the conversation. It will be a wonderful opportunity to share with fellow parishioners what your faith in Jesus Christ means to you.

Obviously this kind of joint venture takes some planning and coordination. Therefore, the diocese is asking each parish to appoint a person to serve as the parish contact for this evening. We are looking for someone here at Trinity to serve in this capacity. The ideal candidate for this position would be a person who is well organized but also has passion for both the ministry of hospitality and evangelism.

If you are that person please contact Fr. Kevin. Sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with those who do not know him often begins by sharing the Good News of God's presence in our lives with those who do know him.

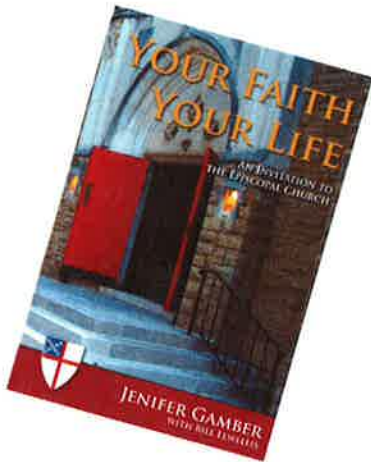

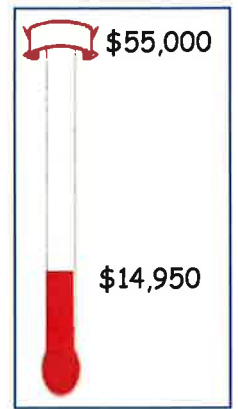

# 2012 Vestry Nominees

**Claire Alford** Claire Alford has been a resident of Longview for six years with her husband, Spencer Alford and son, Bolton Alford. She has formerly served on the Vestry of the Jefferson church as secretary. Claire has traveled extensively locally and abroad. Her main hobbies are Bible study and spiritual growth. She enjoys teaching Vacation Bible School at Trinity Episcopal Church of which she, Spencer and Bolton are proud members.



**Jane Barker** moved to Longview to work with the Samaritan Counseling Center, an international nonprofit pastoral counseling center in 2010. **Harry Barth** is a cradle Episcopalian born and raised in Beaumont, Texas.
