Outreach Kickoff

Palm Sunday (April 10), Between the Services in the Parish Hall

The Outreach Committee met on Tuesday, March 22 to make plans for the remainder of the year. We focused on four doable ministry projects. We are excited and encouraged by the possibilities for your involvement and encourage you to attend this important event. The ministries we are hoping to help with are Family Promise, Newgate Mission (aka Martha's Kitchen), Longview Community Ministries (LCM), and the Mission of the Month and weekly Food Offerings. Details about each ministry, together with contact information, are below:

- Family Promise—We plan to assist with the renovation of the former rectory at St. Michael and All Angels Episcopal Church to contain new offices and hosting space for families experiencing homelessness in our community. Trinity will host a fundraiser and participate in a work day (painting and/or landscaping). Please contact Fr. Bill (frbill@trinityparish.org; 903-399-1190).
- Newgate Mission—We plan to resume assisting with cooking and food service for a free Sunday meal (aka Martha's Kitchen). Bill Charles (wmcharles@aol.com; 903-387-1991) will chair Team One, which is ready to begin. Dot

Fricks (dotwhf@fastmail.net; 903-734-1894) will chair Team Two, which is forming now.

- Longview Community Ministries—We are looking to collaborate with LCM in providing direct assistance people in need. Likely areas of
 interest are volunteers for the Food Basket/Food Pantry, Emergency Assistance (interviewers and clerical assistance), and Meals With

- Mission of the Month and Food Offerings on Sunday—We are going to emphasize Mission of the Month and the weekly food offering in new ways. A large kettle with visual reminders of this month's Mission of the Month will be placed in the center aisle on the second Sunday of each month as a reminder of God's call to give to those in need. In April, the Mission of the Month will be Episcopal Relief and Development in order to support their Ukraine Crisis Response. The basket that we use to bring forward representative, non-perishable food items each week will be redesigned, so that what it contains is more visible and it will be given a more prominent place in the weekly offertory as it is placed on the Altar with our monetary gifts. The recommended list for food donations will be placed in the *Trumpet* each month, as well as in the weekly bulletin.

Everyone is warmly invited to come to the event on Palm Sunday, between the services. Tables representing each of these ministries will be set up in the parish hall and staffed by people who are eager to talk to you about where you would most like to serve. Please pray for this event and come share our joy and excitement.


MISSION OF THE MONTH



UKRAINE CRISIS RESPONSE FUND

Episcopal Relief & Development continues to work with Anglican and ecumenical partners to provide aid to people displaced by the crisis in Ukraine. International Program staff are in close contact with church and ecumenical partners including the ACT Alliance, The Convocation of Episcopal Churches in Europe, the Diocese of Europe, the Anglican Alliance and United Society of Partners in the Gospel. These organizations are coordinating immediate and long-term humanitarian responses through their local partners in Romania, Poland, Hungary and Slovakia.
