Loving God and others, we invite, welcome and embrace all people through worship, fellowship, and service.

A Season of Transitions and New Beginnings: Christian formation resumes in August / a fond farewell to Fr. Andrew and family.

Our new Inquirers' Class begins on Wednesday August 3 at 6 pm and will continue on each of the Wednesday nights prior to Bishop Doyle's Visitation on September 25. If any of you wish to be baptized, confirmed, or received into the Episcopal Church when Bishop Doyle is here, or if you have a child or youth in need of these sacraments and rites of initiation and renewal, this is the ideal time to talk to me (Fr. Bill, 903-399-1190; frbill@trinityparish.org). It is also possible to renew one's baptismal vows in the presence of the Bishop.

We rejoice in Bishop Doyle's presence with us this September. In the Episcopal Church, we believe that bishops are successors of the apostles, charged with continuing the eyewitness testimony to the resurrection of Jesus, overseeing the mission of his Church, and connecting us with his followers in other times and places. Bishop Andy Doyle is our Bishop Diocesan. He serves with a team of four bishops in the Diocese of Texas. This team includes Bishop Jeff Fisher, our own regional bishop whose office is in Tyler. Every Bishop's visitation is an opportunity to widen our vision and be renewed in the Holy Spirit for the work of following Jesus together.

The inquirers' class will occur in the context of our potluck dinner and fellowship on Wednesday nights at 6:00 PM. This year, it is a brand new offering. It is in a video format, with clergy and laity in conversation. Together, we invite the class participants to continue the conversation, in order to explore our Baptismal Covenant and the parish Rule of Life found on the front cover of every bulletin, as well as the history, way of life, and government of the Episcopal Church.

If you can't attend the class, private instruction can also be arranged, but I encourage you to attend the class if at all possible, so that new and established members can have conversation with one another about what it means to follow Jesus in the Episcopal Church. Both the videos and the handouts will be made available for those who are unable to attend the class in person. The class is suitable for adults and older youth. We will arrange age-appropriate instruction for people younger than that, as well as advice about whether confirmation is appropriate for your youth. Generally, confirmation is appropriate for teenagers, with the precise age determined by personal readiness to make an adult, lifelong commitment to following Jesus as Lord and Savior as defined by our Baptismal Covenant

Please also note that all adult Christian formation ministries are restarting in August. Our Lectionary Bible Study at 7:00 AM on Tuesdays at the Silver Grizzly is ongoing and you are always welcome. There is a 2:00 PM spirituality group on Tuesdays which is just starting to read a book by Mark McIntosh and Frank Griswold, entitled Seeds of Faith, which is about our intimate friendship with God through Jesus Christ and its implications. Beginning on August 14, Adult Sunday School and coffee hour will resume between the services at 9:15 AM, with a Bible study on Colossians and 1 Peter, led by Gary Whitwell and me.

As we have previously shared, Fr. Andrew has accepted a call to serve as the Associate Rector at St. Alban's in Waco, with his last Sunday with us on August 7, will necessitate a relatively rapid transition. I encourage you to join us on August 7, where Fr. Andrew will be the preacher at both services, and where Trinity will celebrate him and his family at each service and between the services at 9:15 AM. Please take the time to say thank you and farewell. As hard as it can be, this is important spiritual work that God can use to bless

Lastly, let me share that the search committee for a worthy successor to Fr. Andrew has begun to form, and that our Associate Rector position is being advertised widely, and that many trusted colleagues are helping us to identity appropriate candidates. I am meeting with Fr. Andrew and a small group of lay leaders to establish a transition plan for the next several months, so that we do not lose momentum on youth and children's ministry. More to follow...
