Wondrous Love: Lent and Spiritual Renewal

What wondrous love is this, O my soul, O my soul!
What wondrous love is this, O my soul!
What wondrous love is this
That caused the Lord of bliss
To lay aside his crown for my soul? (Hymn 439)

This old, Appalachian hymn speaks to what Lent is all about. Lent is a season to rediscover Jesus and his love, repent of our sins, and re-engage with the fellowship of Christ's Body, the Church. Here at Trinity, we invite the whole People of God to

"prepare with joy for the Paschal feast." (BCP, p. 379).

This year, Lent begins on February 22 with the solemn liturgy of Ash Wednesday. We will have services at 12:15 PM and 6:00 PM, with the Imposition of Ashes and Holy Eucharist. The pancake supper will be on Tuesday, February 21 at the Hollandsworth Commons at the Trinity School of Texas. Please contact the church office or Fr. Bill if you need directions. (903-399-1190, Fr. On Wednesday nights at 6:00 PM (March 1, 8, 15, 22, and 29 and April 5), we will have our potluck supper and Christian formation. With leadership from both our clergy, we will be reading Ruth Burrows' book, Extravagant Love, together. The book is a consideration of the self-emptying of Jesus (see Philippians 2) as the foundation for the Christian life of prayer and discipleship. We are going to offer the Stations of the Cross again this year, beginning at 7:30 PM. Everyone is welcome to join us for the meal and discussion, or just for the Stations. Children and youth are welcome to join us in leading these prayers, which will be shared among those present.

On Sunday mornings at 9:15 AM (February 26, and March 5, 12, 19, and 26), Mother Vivian will be leading a Bible study on "Praying with the Psalms." Please take this opportunity to get to know our new Associate Rector and grow in your relationship with God.

It is our deep and heartfelt hope that this holy season of Lent will prepare all of us for the annual celebration of the death and resurrection of the Lord. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday (April 2) and it finds its fulfillment in the joy of Easter Day (April 9). On Maundy Thursday (4/6), we celebrate the Holy Eucharist with Footwashing at 7:00 PM. On Good Friday (4/7), we celebrate Morning Prayer at 8:00 AM, the Proper Liturgy at 12:00 noon, and Stations of the Cross at 5:00 PM. Easter Sunday worship is at 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM.

Assist us mercifully with your help, O Lord God of our salvation, that we may enter with joy upon the contemplation of those mighty acts, whereby you have given us life and immortality; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.




