

An Invitation to Easter: "The death of death has happened."



The Rev. Dr. Kara Slade serves as a theologian-in-residence and priest associate at a local parish and as one of the Episcopal chaplains to Princeton University. She has two earned doctorates, both from Duke University. Before she became a priest, she was a Professor of Engineering and a rocket scientist. Her second doctorate is in theology. She is a specialist in the thought of Karl Barth, who was personally involved in the theological struggle against the idolatrous, murderous Nazi regime.

On Twitter a few years ago, Kara responded to a challenge to state one's basic beliefs in six words or less. What she came up with is "The death of death has happened." And that, dearly beloved, is what the Good News of Jesus is all about. As we prepare to enter Holy Week, we celebrate the saving mysteries at the heart of our faith. As we confess in the Creed, the Son of God, who joined us here in our flesh, suffered, died, and rose again

"for us and for our salvation." And, because our Lord died on the Cross, death itself has died. On Easter Day, we celebrate the victory of Jesus over all the fallen powers that "corrupt and destroy the creatures of God." In the end, his victory is over death itself. For he is the Living One, who makes all things new.

A complete schedule of Holy Week and Easter services appears on page 4 (outside cover). I commend our full participation in each and every one of them. In the Name of Jesus, I invite us to gather together at the foot of his Cross and at his Empty Tomb, to discover the joy of his RESURRECTION VICTORY. Every book of the New Testament presupposes this life-changing truth, and the raucous hymns of joy that we sing each Easter echo it down through the centuries. In the words of one of the greatest, written in the eighth century by St. John of Damascus (Hymn #200 in our hymnal):

Tis the spring of souls today: Christ has burst his prison, And from three days' sleep in death, as a sun hath risen; All the winter of our sins, long and dark, is flying From his light, to whom we give laud and praise undying.

Or, in the words of another (#208), which we often use at funerals:

The powers of death have done their worst,

But Christ their legions hath dispersed.

Let shout of holy joy outburst:

Alleluia!

Dearly beloved, "the death of death has happened." Jesus has broken its fearful power over us. And so, God's new world has begun.

I was stunned and had no response. How could someone who had read my file and spoken to me for only an hour know that I had been harboring those very feelings? It is human nature, really. Our world is so competitive. We are pushed to be the best at everything - sports, school, love, parenthood, work, finances, sleep, friendships. No

human being can be all of the things that society tells us we should be.

One thing I have finally learned is that the truly important tasks come from God. He calls us and, if we are listening, oh what an adventure it will be! Scary, thrilling, difficult, out of our control, glorious. This Lent, lay aside the hurt, shame, and blame in our lives and LISTEN to only God. Then we can really getdown to why we are here and what we can do for the world through Jesus Christ.




