Founded in 1988, Windridge Therapeutic Center is making great strides in the lives of children and adults by providing therapeutic horsemanship programs, physical therapies, academics, and life skills. Windridge's therapeutic horsemanship programs are funded by individuals, corporations, churches, and civic organizations. Donations received in support of these programs are investments in lives of children and adults with disabilities. Windridge is home to more than 140 participants and 70+ volunteers a week, 9 full time staff members, and 24 horses.

A Word from Mother Vivian

Do You Feel Connected? We are brothers and sisters in Christ and experience this through worship services, the study of God's Word, and service to those in need. It is by spending time together that we can get to know each other and enter a deeper Christian relationship.

Our society is suffering from a lack of connectedness, or "social fitness," as Derek Thompson states in his article Why Americans Suddenly Stopped Hanging Out.' The 2003 – 2022 statistics are astounding:

Men reduced socializing by 30% The unmarried by 35% Teenagers by 45%

All human beings have the need to belong, to be accepted, to be loved. We also need human beings that we can love, laugh with and care for. I believe that deep down we all need this and are lacking, either in experiencing this ourselves or providing it for others. As we experience this season of Lent and enter into Holy Week and Easter, I would ask you to think about how connected you feel and to what and to whom?
