### A Meditation on Baptism for the Day of Pentecost June 8, 2025

The world is charged with the grandeur of God.

It will flame out, like shining from shook foil;

It gathers to a greatness, like the ooze of oil

Crushed. Why do men then now not reck his rod?

Generations have trod, have trod, have trod;

And all is seared with trade; bleared, smeared with toil;

And wears man's smudge and shares man's smell: the soil

Is bare now, nor can foot feel, being shod.

And for all this, nature is never spent;
There lives the dearest freshness deep down things;
And though the last lights off the black West went
Oh, morning, at the brown brink eastward, springs—
Because the Holy Ghost over the bent
World broods with warm breast and with ah! bright wings.
--Gerard Manley Hopkins, "God's Grandeur"



This poem speaks of the glorious, consoling presence of God's *Spirit* in the *world*. Too often, we refuse God's ways and trample on God's creation: "All is seared with trade; bleared, smeared with toil/And wears man's smudge and shares man's smell: the soil/is bare now, nor can foot feel, for being shod." And yet, the world remains "charged with the grandeur of God"—and therein lies our salvation. For Hopkins, "nature is never spent;/There lives the dearest freshness deep down things." And all this, because "the Holy Ghost over the bent world broods, with warm breast and with (AH!) bright wings."

On the Day of Pentecost (June 8) this year, we will celebrate Holy Baptism at 10:30 AM and renew our Baptismal vows at both services. Whenever we celebrate it, Baptism provides us an occasion for spiritual renewal. By water and the Spirit, God gives us ALL a fresh start. God renews us ALL (not just the person being baptized) in the gift of the Holy Spirit. Grace is one of the names of the Holy Spirit—the third person of the Trinity. Many theologians consider the Spirit to be the *feminine* face of God. In Scripture, the Spirit is God's boundless love—the source of our freedom in Jesus. She is like the *wind*, who moves wherever she wants to.

Together with Jesus himself, the Spirit is God's greatest gift to us. We don't pay for gifts. People give them to us, because they love us and want to make us happy. In the Episcopal Church, we baptize children and babies, as well as older youth and adults, as a sign of God's free grace. We claim God's grace in Holy Baptism. There, we are made one with Jesus in his dying and rising. There, he gives us the same Spirit who fills his heart—to fill our hearts with his own love. We join the family of Jesus, which he gathers together from every language, tribe, race, and nation.

Come, Holy Spirit!
